M E M O R A N D U M

of Cooperation between

the State Communications Agency under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic
and
the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania

17 October 2011 No. ND-266
Bishkek 2011

The State Communications Agency under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic and the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania hereinafter referred to as "the Parties";

DESIRING enhanced promotion of close and friendly relations between the Parties;

RECOGNISING the importance of competition and growth of electronic communications sector and the influence thereof on the economic development of each country;

TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION significance of effective regulation of electronic communications sector;

BASED on mutual desire to extend partnership and support with respect to the development of electronic communications sector in accordance with the effective acts of international and regional organizations of which the Kyrgyz Republic and Republic of Lithuania are members, international commitments and the national legislation of each Party's State as well as the provisions of this Memorandum and acting within their competence;

have agreed as follows:

TIKRA

Article 1

The Purpose of the Memorandum

- 1.1. The purpose of this Memorandum shall be facilitation of co-operation in the field of electronic communications regulation by means of exchange of information and experience, support and promotion of joint measures.

Article 2

Scope of Co-operation

- 2.1. In line with rapid progress in electronic communications sector the following co-operation areas shall be determined:

- 2.1.1. to take reasonable measures to explore the development of electronic communications sector in the countries of the Parties;

- 2.1.2. to facilitate the development of high quality effective electronic communications services;

- 2.1.3. to exchange information on active co-operation within the framework of joint projects in the field of electronic communications regulation;

- 2.1.4. subject to available resources and upon further agreement of the parties, to provide the appropriate specialists and experts and make the arrangements for joint meetings, seminars, workshops in the field of electronic communications regulation.

- 2.2. Other agreed forms of co-operation might be elaborated.

Article 3

Relation to other agreements and treaties

- 3.1 This Memorandum of Cooperation shall not affect any rights and obligations under any international treaties of the Parties' States and agreements of Parties.

Article 4

Confidentiality of information

4.1. Each Party shall ensure the confidentiality of the information received from the other Party. The information received within the framework of this Memorandum shall not be transferred to the third party without the written permission of the Party which has provided this information.

Article 5


Commencement and Duration

5.1. Activities under this Memorandum may commence as of the date of signature and continue for a period of [five] years, unless ended by the State Communications Agency under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic or the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania by written notice, within a three-month period prior to such conclusion.

5.2. This Memorandum may be modified or continued for additional periods by mutual consent of the Parties.



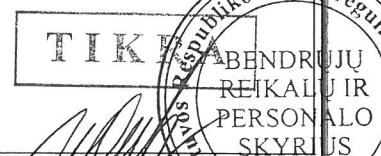
