AGREEMENT ON THE EXTENSION OF

VALIDITY OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE GEORGIAN NATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AND THE COMMUNICATIONS REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA

The Georgian National Communications Commission and the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter – the Parties), recognising that the Memorandum of Understanding between the Georgian National Communications Commission and the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter – Memorandum of Understanding) signed on 1 July 2011 in Trakai, Lithuania, is valid until 1 July 2016,

considering Paragraph 5.2 of Article V of Memorandum of Understanding, have agreed:

Article I

The validity of Memorandum of Understanding shall be extended for the period of the following one year, until 1 July 2017.

Article II

This Agreement shall enter into force on 2 July 2016.
